1 At the request of both sides, and since the contesting respondents have no objection, the proceedings pending before the Debt Recovery Tribunal, Pune, shall stand transferred to Debt Recovery Tribunal, Mumbai.

2 For a period of four weeks from today, any ad-interim order passed in Securitisation Application No.213 of 2015 to continue, but without prejudice to the rights and contentions of all parties.

3 Since the relief claimed is based on the Division Bench judgment of this court, the writ petition is allowed.

No other order or direction is necessary.

4 It will be open for respondent no.2 bank to make an application to the learned Chairperson to consolidate and club all proceedings involving the present petitioner and others for a decision by Debt Recovery Tribunal-I, Mumbai, and to avoid any conflict in the orders.

5 All concerned to act on an authenticated copy of the order.
