ORAL ORDER [PER SMT. V.K. TAHILRAMANI, J.] :

3. By Judgment & Order dated 15.5.2009 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sewree, Mumbai in Sessions Case No. 849 of 2007, the petitioner was convicted

under Sections 302 and 449 read with 34 of IPC. Being aggrieved thereby, the petitioner preferred Criminal Appeal No. 582 of 2011. This Court, by Judgment & Order dated 19.12.2014 acquitted the petitioner of all the offences. Pursuant to the said Judgment & Order of acquittal, the petitioner has been released from prison on 22.12.2014.

4. In view of the above, the Writ Petition is infructuous, hence, rule is discharged.
