1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant.
2. By this application, the Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 429 days in filing the aforesaid Revision.
3. Learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that the delay

taken out by the registry is technical inasmuch as, the applicant had earlier filed a Revision Application being Criminal Revision Application No.269 of 2015 and that the said Revision Application was filed well within limitation. He submitted that the said revision application was admitted by this Court. He further submitted that thereafter the applicant had moved two applications, being Criminal Application Nos.149 and 169 of 2016 seeking amendment of the Revision Application, in particular the prayer clauses in the revision application.
