2. Perusal of the trial Court's order
shows that suit proceeded exparte
against defendants no. 2 and 3. Applicant
(original defendant no.1) is the only
contesting defendant. The Courts below
have decreed the suit instituted by
respondent no.1-original plaintiff. In

view thereof and having regard to the fact that the delay is of 10 days, I am satisfied that the applicants have made out sufficient case for condoning the delay. Hence, Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a) with no order as to costs.
