3. Civil application is for restoration of the above petition.

The writ petition was placed before the Registrar (Judicial-I) on

14.12.2015 and the Petitioner was directed to remove the office

objections within four weeks failing which registration of writ petition was to stand refused. The Petitioner did not remove office objection, therefore, the petition stood dismissed. The petition was dismissed even prior to issuance of notice to Respondent, hence presence of respondent is not necessary to dispose of this civil application.
