Application No.1511 of 2015 for expeditious hearing of the Criminal Appeal. By an Order dated 15.12.2015 while allowing the said application, this Court had directed that the appeal be fixed for final hearing in the second week of February 2016. As per the contention of the applicant the said Advocates lost their interest in conducting the present appeal.
