

2. Counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that forged

documents were used by the accused for which cognizance is required to be taken.

3. We have perused the record and considered the submissions advanced. In the facts of the case, we are not inclined to issue directions as prayed for by the petitioner. However, the petitioner is at liberty to resort to appropriate alternate remedy as prescribed in the Criminal Procedure Code.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the allegations made by the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of.
