1. Heard. This Application is made by the Defendant for substitute service on respondent No.1 original Plaintiff. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the notice issued by them by R.P.A.D. on 18.11.2014 returned unserved with postal remark "due to insufficient address".

2. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the address of respondent No.1 is shown in the Civil Application on the basis of the address given by her in the plaint itself. He submits that they tried to find out the present correct address, but in vain. Hence, they made Civil Application for substitute service.
