2. These are the Applications for condoning the delay of 12 days caused in filing the Civil Revision Applications.

7. In view thereof, on the motion made by Mr. Aggarwal, leave to withdraw Civil Revision Applications with liberty as prayed for is granted. It is made clear that I have not examined merits of C.R.As.
