2. Heard Mr. Punde, learned Counsel for petitioners and Mr. Tapkir, learned Counsel for respondent.

3. Mr. Punde has tendered letter dated 06.06.2016 addressed by the petitioners to him. The same is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. Mr. Punde states that on 03.01.2016, sole respondent expired leaving behind Mr. Vinod D. Kulkarni as her only heir. In the letter, it is stated that petitioners have amicably settled their dispute with Mr. Vinod D. Kulkarni, out of Court.
