1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.
2. This petition is filed seeking direction to respondent Nos. 6 and 7 to register F.I.R. against respondent Nos.1 & 2. By order dated 25th October, 2016, statement of learned APP that “within seven days from that date, the team of experts would submit its opinion”, was recorded.
3. Mr. Yagnik, learned APP placed on record the report dated 27.10.2015 of the Expert Committee. The same is taken on record and marked “X” for identification. The said report discloses negligence on the part of respondent Nos. 1 & 2. Mr. Yagnik, having taken instructions,
