1. Heard learned Counsel for the applicant and the learned A.P.P for the State.

2. By this application, the applicant seeks quashing and setting aside of the order dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 passed by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 7<sup>th</sup> Court, Dadar, by which, non-bailable warrant came to be issued against the applicant. Learned Counsel for the applicant states that after the non-bailable warrant was issued by the learned Judge on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2016, the applicant preferred an application on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2016

seeking cancellation of the non-bailable warrant. He submits that till date, the said application has not been heard and decided by the learned Judge.
