1. Learned APP submits that a first information report ('FIR') was registered on 25 April 2016. The complaint was filed by the Petitioner on 7 July 2015 addressed to the Administrator, Silvassa with copy to Khanvel Police Station. We find substance in the submission of learned counsel for the Petitioner that though the complaint was made on 7 July 2015 with a copy to Khanvel Police Station, Police took one year to register FIR.
