1 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2 By this Contempt Petition petitioner allege that the respondent nos.1 to 3 failed and neglected to comply the order dated 8.6.2015 passed by this court in Writ Petition No.1015 of 2015.

3 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this court by order dated 8.6.2015 dismissed respondent nos.1 to 3's Approval Application No.NTB-10 of 2004. He submits that in view of dismissal of Approval Application it is the duty of respondent nos.1 to 3 to re-employ the

petitioner. In support of this contention, he relies on the judgment of the Apex Court in the matter of *Jaipur Zilla Sahakari Bhoomi Vikas Bank Ltd. vs. Shri Ram Gopal Sharma and Ors., 2002(1) CLR 789.*

4 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5 It is to be noted that this court by order dated 8.6.2015 dismissed respondent nos.1 to 3's Approval Application No.NTB-10 of 2004. This court has not directed respondent nos.1 to 3 either to re-employ or pay back wages to the petitioner.

6 Considering these facts, I do not find any reason to entertain the present Contempt Petition.

7 Hence, Contempt Petition stands rejected.
