especially the applicant No.2, who is minor and applicant No.1 needs money for his education and applicant No.3 being old mother of the deceased needs money for her medical expenses, applicants may be permitted to withdraw substantial amounts.

4. Learned counsel for respondent herein i.e. appellant submits that previous amounts were allowed to be withdrawn subject to claim petition being decided. It is submitted that the accident occurred due to sole negligence of the deceased. In my considered opinion, in view of the requirement of the applicants, application needs to be and is allowed by passing following order.

Order

Applicant No.1 is permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.10,00,000/-; whereas applicant No.3 is permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- subject to usual undertaking.
