1] This application is preferred by the original Claimant Nos.1 and 2 seeking withdrawal of the amount of compensation as deposited by respondent-Insurance Company in the Tribunal.

2] Considering the requirements of the Original Claimant Nos.1 and 2 and having regard to the fact that Appeal is not likely to be heard immediately, the Applicant No.1 is permitted to withdraw 50% amount of her share. As regards Applicant No.2 who is minor, Applicant No.1 is also permitted to withdraw quarterly interest amount on the share of the amount of Applicant No.2 which is

deposited in the “Nationalized Bank”. Applicant No.1 is permitted to withdraw the amount of her share and interest on the amount of share of Applicant No.2, subject to furnishing of usual undertaking.

3] Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
