1. Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 and the learned APP.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 19th August, 2016, the petitioners have deposited a sum of

Rs.2,65,193/- in the Appellate Court.

3. Learned Counsel for the Respondent No.1 – Bank states that the respondent no.1 – Bank be permitted to withdraw the aforesaid amount of Rs.2,65,193/- which is deposited by the petitioners in the Appellate Court.
