2. Mr. Deshmukh, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the question involved in these petitions is covered by the order dated 21st September, 2013, passed by the Division Bench of this

Court in the case of Kiran Namdeo Shinde and ors. vs. the State of Maharashtra and ors. in writ petition No.2358 of 2013 and other connected writ petitions. He submitted that these petitions may be disposed of by directing the appropriate authority to consider and take an appropriate decision on the petitioners' claim.
