This is Civil Application for extending the time to pass necessary orders on the application for stay.

against recovery by coercive means may also continue till the
Tribunal passes the necessary orders on the stay application.

since the matter was earlier argued before the Tribunal, we extend
the time for disposal of the application till 19th September, 2016.
We expect the Revenue not to take any coercive measures till the
final orders are passed on the Application.
