3. Learned Counsel for the Respondent No.1 has tendered an

He shall withdraw the criminal complaint being Criminal Case No.1134 of 2015, which is pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Court No.1, Ichalkaranji, Kolhapur, within three weeks from today, in view of the settlement between him and the petitioners, and as he

has received an amount of Rs.60,000/- from the petitioners, by way of full and final settlement.

6. In view of the undertaking given by the Respondent No.1, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition and seeks leave to withdraw the same.

7. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
