2. Office has placed this matter for Speaking to the Minutes of the order dated 26.9.2016. In paragraph 8 of that order, the submission made on behalf of the respondents that respondent no.3 has deposited Rs.70,000/- on 17.9.2016, was recorded. Mr. Hariarkar appearing for the petitioners also did not dispute the fact that respondent no.3 deposited that amount. Mr. Hariakar submitted that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the said amount.
