1. This writ petition was filed on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2013, and thereafter was listed on 11 occasions. No attempt has been made to obtain any relief in terms of the prayers in the writ petition. In fact, this Court found that on 24<sup>th</sup> December, 2014, the petitioners and their advocate were absent. It was adjourned to 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.
