- 1 Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.
- 2 This application is for setting aside the order dated 27.1.2012 passed by learned Additional Registrar by which the Registration of Civil Revision Application as well as Civil Application (Stamp) was rejected for non-removal of office objections.
