1). The applicants are seeking regular bail in Crime No. 80 of 2016 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 506(II), 504, 323 read with Section 34 Indian Penal Code and Sections 4 and 25 of the Arms Act.

- 2). Perused the papers. Chargesheet in the matter is already filed. There is recovery of sword from the accused persons.
- 3). Accused, Sakina to whom major role is attributed is already released on bail. The role attributed to the applicants is that of causing simple injuries.
