1). This Civil Application is for restoration of the Appeal from Order against respondents no.1 to 7. The Appeal from Order was dismissed against them for non-service. Mr. Dhavale, learned Advocate appearing for the applicant states that, the contesting parties are infact respondents no.8 and 9. Perusal of the application before the trial Court, shows that the interim relief sought by the applicant is only against respondent no.9.
