Heard Mr. Shah, learned Counsel for petitioner and Mr. Kulkarni, learned Counsel for respondent.

2. Mr. Shah submitted that minutes of consent order dated 21.08.2012 duly signed by the petitioner and respondent as well as their Advocates were tendered before this Court in three Writ Petitions. By order dated 21.08.2012, this Court disposed of those Petitions after accepting the undertakings given in paragraphs 2, 5 and 6. Contempt Petition was filed alleging breach of order dated 21.08.2012 in terms of the minutes of the consent order dated 21.08.2012.
