2. This application is for stay to the execution of the judgment and award dated passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Pune, in MACP No.101 of 2014
2. Learned counsel for the applicant makes a statement that the applicant is ready to deposit the entire decretal amount in the Tribunal, within four weeks from the date of this order. Statement is accepted.
3. In view thereof, stay is granted to the execution and implementation of the award in terms of prayer clause (a) subject to condition that the applicant deposits the entire amount within a period of four weeks, in the Tribunal, from today.

4. Amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited in this Court, be transferred to Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Pune.
5. Amount that will be deposited in the Tribunal alongwith amount of Rs.25,000/- (on transfer), the Tribunal to invest both the amounts in any nominalized bank, initially for a period of one year and thereafter to be renewed from time to time till disposal of the appeal. On applicant's failure to deposit the entire amount within the stipulated period, the stay granted shall be stand vacated automatically and the application shall stand dismissed without further reference to this Court.
3. Application stands disposed of accordingly.
