- 2 These two applications are preferred by third party for joining them as party respondent in the present Writ Petitions.
- 3 At the time of hearing, the learned counsel

for the petitioner raised preliminary objection about maintainability of Civil Applications on the ground that the Apex Court by order dated 11.12.2012 directed applicant to pay cost of Rs.15,000/- to the Charity Commissioner within six weeks.

4 The learned counsel for the applicant after taking instructions from his client makes a statement that they complied the order passed by Apex Court dated 11.12.2012 within time. That is, they paid cost of Rs.15,000/- to the Charity Commissioner within six weeks from the date of order.
