

was taken to St. George Hospital and produced the report.

5. I have perused the earlier orders. It appears that by the order dated 1st August, 2014, the applicant/accused was released on temporary bail as his wife was suffering from cancer. Secondly, on 30th October, 2014 he was released on temporary bail for same reason. In the Government Hospital a good dental treatment is available so this is not a ground to grant temporary bail. The Application is rejected with following directions to the Jail as well as Hospital Authorities:

- (i) Superintendent of Thane prison is hereby directed to send the accused for his dental treatment in the month of April, May and June whenever he is called by the Dental Surgeon of the Hospital. Initially, he is to be taken to Thane Civil Hospital and thereafter he is to be sent to St. George Hospital. No excuse of escort is to be given.
- (ii) The Superintendent of Thane prison is directed to submit the report before the Sessions Court, Dindoshi.
