5. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for
interim relief.

6. By way of interim relief the petitioner has
prayed for release of the amount of unpaid fertilizer
subsidy. Grant of such interim relief would amount

to grant of final relief which, in the facts and circumstances of the case, cannot be done. Merely because subsidy is released to another company, the petitioner cannot get that monetary relief by way of interim relief. Hence, no interim relief. Civil application for interim relief is, accordingly, disposed of.
