3. According to the Petitioner he had submitted a representation dated 17th September, 2016 (Exhibit D) along with the recommendation of the Management dated 6th October, 2016 (Exhibit H) before Respondent No. 4 in regard to the proposed decision as to declaring him as a surplus teacher.
