1. Learned Counsel for the Petitioners seeks leave to withdraw this petition, in view of the subsequent developments.

2. It may be noted that in the aforesaid petition the petitioners had impugned the order dated 12th March, 2015 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, 27th Court, Pune, by which charge was framed as

against the petitioners as well as the Judgment and Order dated 13th August, 2015, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pune, dismissing the Revision filed by the petitioners before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pune.
