1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present contempt petition is arising out of the order dated 5th October 2012 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, at Bandra, Mumbai, in Interim Application No. 127 of 2011 and the order dated 22nd March 2013 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No. 1379 of 2013 for non payment of maintenance charges.
