

31st March, 2013 by G. R. the State Government has again started giving non salary grants to the aided schools. In view of this statement, nothing survives in the PIL. The policy decision of not paying non-salary grants to the aided schools cannot be questioned by filing PIL under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, since the Government is entitled to take policy decision in respect of financial matters. In view of the statement made, on instructions, by the learned AGP Mr. N. P. Deshpande, appearing on behalf of the State, PIL is disposed of.
