

4 Mr.Yagnik, learned APP, having taken instructions from the officer concerned, makes a statement that the investigation is almost complete in the said CR. The articles are recovered under the panchanama. He submits that the charge sheet could not be filed, as ad-interim order of not to arrest was passed in the anticipatory bail application filed by the accused in the subject crime. He further states that in the event, the Respondent accused is granted anticipatory bail, he will be formally arrested, thereafter charge sheet would be filed, as expeditiously as possible.

5 In the light of above, we do not find any merit in the allegations of the Petitioner which are made on the basis of non recovery of the Petitioner's ornaments. The investigation in the said crime is satisfactory. We do not find any need to transfer the said investigation to any other independent agency.

6 The petition is devoid of any merit and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
