The civil application is filed for condonation of delay of one year and nineteen days.

2. The Applicant was working as a labourer in the garden department of the Respondent Corporation. The dispute that was raised by the Applicant, was regarding removal of the Applicant from service. The reason given in the application is that, after removal from service, the Applicant was not keeping well and the financial condition also deteriorated. It is stated that the Applicant is of 62

years old and he was under impression that the Respondent Corporation would take him back in service.
