1. The Civil Application is moved for condonation of delay of 34 days in filing the appeal.
2. The learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant/original plaintiff was suffering from hypertension, blood pressure and, therefore, he was advised to take bed rest. He was also advised to be hospitalised and hence the delay is caused.
