The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner on instruction seeks permission to withdrawn the petition with liberty to prosecute the appeal dated 9<sup>th</sup> November 2015 a copy of which is annexed as Exhibit 'E' to the affidavit-in-reply of Shri Rajendra Jayram Jadhav, Joint Commissioner, Fisheries.
