1 The above Civil Application has been filed by the Applicant for being permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs.3,30,150/- out of the total amount of Rs.13,20,600/-deposited by the United India Insurance Co. Ltd. in MACT, Khed, District Ratnagiri. The withdrawal is sought on the ground that the Applicant has to pay fees for the engineering course for which she has taken admission in Zind College of Engineering, Pune.
