learned counsel for the applicant.

2. This is an application for
condonation of delay of 15 days in filing
Civil Revision Application. By order
dated 4.4.2016, Rule was issued and in
addition to court service, the applicant
was permitted to serve the respondent by
private notice. Accordingly, the applicant
has filed affidavit of service along with
acknowledgment indicating service on
respondent. Office remark shows that the
respondent has sent reply dated
24.4.2016 to the letter dated 15.4.2016
