(iii) and (iv) above are concerned, she on instructions submitted that if the applicant submits the necessary Compact Disks and/or Hard Disk to the respondent No.1, the officers of respondent No.1 would copy the data from the original one and will handover the copies of the same to the applicant herein within a period of 3 weeks from the date of receipt of said CD's and/or Hard Disks. The learned counsel for the applicant has no objection for the same.

In view of the above, the application is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
