1. The Court Receiver's Report is allowed in terms of prayer Clauses (a) and (b), which are reproduced hereunder :

“(a) The Court Receiver be discharged without passing accounts and Petitioner may be directed to pay cost, charges and expenses of the Court Receiver of Rs.8,000/- in the office of Court Receiver within stipulated period of time as may be directed by the Hon'ble Court.

(b) Cost of this report be awarded in the sum of Rs.3,000/- and the Petitioner may be directed to deposit the same with the Court Receiver within stipulated period of time as may be directed by the Hon'ble Court.”

2. The Petitioner through its Advocate undertakes to pay the dues of the Court Receiver including costs, within a period of two weeks from today. The undertaking is accepted. The Report is accordingly disposed of.
