The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Meera Mahadev Rai, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where she was ordinarily resident, on 27th August 2013. A copy of her death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by her three sons and a daughter. Their names are mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 4 of the petition.

2. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required for the purposes of transfer of an allotment in a Slum Rehabilitation scheme at B/22, Sanjay Gandhi Nagar, General A.K. Vaidya Marg, Gokuldharm, Malad (East), Mumbai 400 097.
