1 The counsel appearing for the plaintiffs states that the summons for judgment has been served upon the defendants' Advocate on 16.4.2016. 2 Under Order 37 Rule-3 sub-rule 6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, at the hearing of summons for judgment if the defendant has not applied for leave to defend, the plaintiff shall be entitled to a judgment forthwith.

affidavit in reply seeking leave to defend. Nobody is present for the defendants when the matter was called out. Therefore, summons for judgment is made absolute and accordingly disposed. Suit also accordingly decreed.
