1. This Appeal relates to Assessment Year 1997-98. None appears for the Appellant Revenue. It appears that the Revenue is not interested in pursuing this Appeal. Moreover, the tax effect involved in the present appeal as indicated in para 11 of the Appeal Memo is Rs.7,26,620/-. Therefore, in view of the Central Board of direct Tax Circular No.21/15 dated 10th December 2015, the tax effect being less than the threshold limits provided therein for
