The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Dattaram Kashinath Gavankar, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 10th July 2003.
