1 The defendants were granted conditional leave to defend vide a order dated 22nd September, 2015 and the condition was that the defendants to deposit a sum of Rs.3 crores in the court within a period of eight weeks. The defendants preferred an appeal and the appeal came to be dismissed by an order dated 22nd February, 2016. I was told on 15th April, 2016 that the defendants have preferred a review of the order dated 22nd February, 2016.

2 Admittedly, the defendants have not complied with the conditional order. Admittedly the review petition is not yet heard. Admittedly there is no stay against the suit proceedings.

3 As the defendants have not complied with the conditional order, the suit is decreed. Decree be drawn up accordingly.
