The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Dahyabhai Somchand Shah, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 15th June 2014. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by his widow, three sons and a daughter. Their names are mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 2 of the petition.
