The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Maajhanbi Imamsahab Shaikh, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 21st July 2011. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by one son and two daughters. Their names are mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 4 of the petition. The first of these is the Petitioner.

2. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required in relation to a hutment structure at Garub Nagar, Anand Kanekar Marg, Bandra (East), Mumbai.
