1. On 4th March, 2016 this Court passed the following order :

“By consent of the parties, Mr. Ankit Lohia, Advocate, is proposed to be appointed as the sole Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties arising of the Agreement dated 5th February, 2014. In view thereof, Mr. Ankit Lohia, Advocate shall submit disclosure under Section 11 (8) read with Section 12 (1) of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

2. The Advocates for the parties shall forward a copy of this order to Mr. Ankit Lohia, Advocate.

3. All concerned to act on an ordinary copy of this order, duly authenticated by the learned Associate of this Court.

4. *Stand over to 11th March, 2016.*”

2. Pursuant to the above order, Mr. Ankit Lohia, Advocate has filed disclosure dated 11-03-2016 under Section 11(8) read with Section 12(1) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The learned Advocates for the parties have gone through the Disclosure and have no objection to the same. The same is taken on record. In view thereof, the following order is passed by consent :

- i. The disputes arising out of the Agreement dated 5th February, 2014 between the parties are referred to the sole Arbitration of Mr. Ankit Lohia, Advocate.
 - ii. The parties shall appear before the learned Arbitrator in his chambers, on 16th March, 2016 at 5.30 p.m. and obtain necessary directions.
 - iii. The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne by the parties equally.
 - iv. All contentions of the parties are kept open.
 - v. The venue of Arbitration shall be at Mumbai.
3. In view of this order, the above Arbitration Applications are disposed of.
